Special Puppy Dog: (1) 1st Brookes Kyrenia Forty Four, Quality 9 month red of excellent type, pleasing head and eye, short & compact with deep body, well off for bone, in good coat and condition, moved soundly but needs more confidence on the move.

Special Novice Dog: (2, 1) 1st Whitehead's Amaclassic Black Onyx, attractive black, balanced throughout, pleasing head and expression, short back with well ribbed body, good legs and feet, lovely flat coat, moved with enthusiasm.

Special Open Dog: (3,1) 1st Kew's Lujesa Starman, quality black dog, lovely head and expression, excellent shape and balance, well ribbed body, excellent angulation and strong quarters, moved soundly with drive, very well presented RCC. 2nd Ellison's Sh Ch Withiflor Rolling Stone JW, attractive red dog, standing four square, balanced head with soft expression, short deep body, well boned legs and tight feet, good coat and condition moved well.

Minor Puppy Dog: (3, 1) 1st Driver's Annilann Mister Spangles At Beckaby, very pleasing blue, lovely head and expression, good neck and shoulders, firm body, good legs and feet, moved with confidence BMPD. 2nd Edgington's Uxendal Rather Dashing, promising puppy, pleasing head, short with well ribbed body, well off for bone not as forward as one, moved well.

Puppy Dog: (3) 1st Sheridan's Lujesa Living the Dream, very well presented black dog standing full square, good legs and feet sweet head, dark eye, moved soundly with confidence, BPD. 2nd Brookes Kyrenia Forty Four, 3rd Jenkins Bruxly Bandolero.

Junior Dog: (6) Excellent class of quality dogs. 1st Harrison's Lourisma New Statesman, blue of excellent type, cocker all through, lovely balanced head & expression, short & compact with good spring off ribs, good angulation throughout, excellent legs and tight feet, short hocks, moved soundly and showed well, please to award him the CC & RBIS. 2nd Grice's Brackjack Ollison At Kyna, another blue of lovely type and quality, pleasing head with soft expression, well off for bone, sound on the move. 3rd Quigley's Abbzig My Eyea Adore You.

Yearling Dog: (1) 1st Warrington's Zakova Sunburst, Quality red, good outline, good neck & shoulders, well ribbed, short coupled, sound in movement, very well presented.

Maiden Dog: (1) 1st Whitehead's Ammaclassic Black Onyx.

Undergraduate Dog: (3, 1) 1st Palmer's Tarrendayle Forever Yours At Robraine, quality dog, lovely head and expression, short coupled, level topline, super legs and feet, moved and showed well. 2nd Share-Jones Sharemead The Conqueror.

Special Beginners Dog: (4, 1) 1st Quigley's Abbzig My Eyes Adore You, very nice type of blue, excellent conformation, sound in movement, short backed with good spring of rib, good legs and feet. 2nd Jarman's Acquelin Double Fara Flare, attractive blue, short & compact, good legs and feet in lovely condition, a little less weight on the shoulders would be an advantage. 3rd Pitt's Arnegale Making Memories.

Post Graduate Dog: (4, 1) 1st Rofe's Oakrosa Raiden, stylish black with pleasing head, good neck and shoulder placement, well off for bone, presentation first class and moved with drive. 2nd Pretty's Joaldy Best Mate JW, attractive blue dog, very compact, well ribbed body moved and showed well. 3rd Forfar's Bartonholm Bacetta At Glasedin.

Limit Dog: (6, 2) 1st Robertson's Kastrian Affection JW, eyecatching quality black, super outline, well ribbed body, pleasing head & expression, good neck & shoulder placement, moved and showed well, excellent presentation. 2nd Collins Cachel King Of Hearts At Candyke JW, very cockery and typy blue, good head, well balanced throughout, good legs and feet, nicely presented. 3rd Bowen's Charbonnel Rich N'Famous.
